MY LIFE IN HITLER'S GERMANY 2x52'

In 1939, Harvard organized a writing contest among exiled Germans on why they had fled the Nazi regime. 280 people answered from 20 countries and the university received over 20.000 leaflets. A unique testimony illustrated by personal and family archives and news reels from the time. They all lived under Hitler in Germany, they all fled, they all tell their stories: the persecuted Jews, the harassed opposition, the muzzled press. How day by day their country was crushed by the dictatorship.



SEX REVOLUTIONS 2x52' From the 1950s to 2000s, from New York to Paris, this documentary series traces the process of the sexual revolution that was first seen as a libertarian and social revolution before becoming the symbol of a profound societal revolution.


