THE SHETLANDS



TUNISIA, THE SECRET OF THE OCTOPUS FISHERMEN



The fishermen of the Islands Kerkennah of Tunisia set sail for the ocean equipped with just a clay jug, a stick and a trident. But their archaic vessels are effective traps: every morning after sunrise, the Tunisian fishermen haul in an abundant catch.

Ranger Simon Gitau and two of his colleagues carry out their patrol by the light of their headlamps. They fight their way through the thickets of the rainforest of Mount Kenya. The previous day, they discovered traps that had been laid to catch Sykes' monkeys.

The Strait of Gibraltar is one of the most highly frequented straits in the world. About 8 million passengers are ferried across it from Europe to Africa or vice versa. Nowhere else is the distance between the two continents closer than here.

MOSUO, CHINA, THE WORLD'S LAST MATRIARCHY



China, the Himalayas: the Mosuo are a community of over 35,000 people, with, first and foremost, one thing in common - women bear responsibility for the fortune of the family, are in control of business activities, and bequeath property and their name to their daughters.

INDIA, THE BIGGEST SCHOOL MEAL IN THE WORLD



The Indian NGO Akshaya Patra runs 17 industrial kitchens in eight Indian states, and feeds 120 million students. These are children whose parents cannot afford a warm meal for their offspring. In the city of Hubli-Dharwad alone, 180,000 children are catered for every day.

THE KOALA HOSPITAL



Today, only a few thousand remaining koalas live on Koala Coast in the Southeast of Queensland. Throughout Australia, there are between just 40,000 and 100,000 animals. A highly professional Koala Hospital, financed by donations, is located in New South Wales.

A HOSPITAL FOR FLYING FOXES



Jenny MacLean is the founder of a hospital for flying fox bats in the north of Australia, in Queensland. Every year, between November and January, all the flying foxes in the area are being infected by an unexplored disease.
