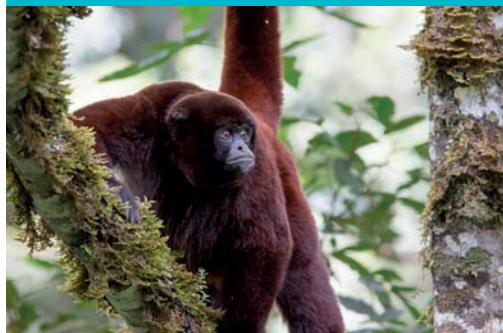

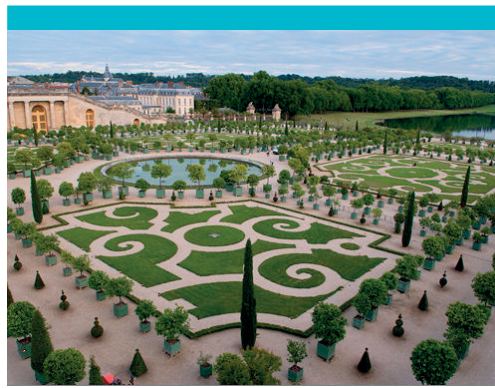
ANIMALS IN FOCUS 15x26'

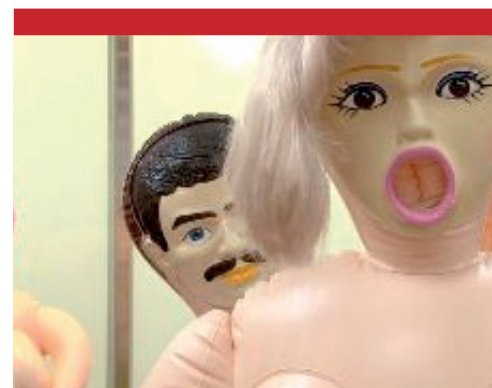
THE APOCALYPSE 12x52'
